

Princeton Golf Club Liquor Policy

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to ensure the safe and responsible consumption of alcoholic beverages at Princeton Golf Course, promoting a friendly and enjoyable environment for all members and guests while maintaining compliance with local laws and PGC Liquor Policy.

Scope

This policy applies to all members, guests, employees, and contractors of Princeton Golf Course who are present on the golf course, clubhouse, and all related facilities.

Outside Alcohol & Penalties for Violation

- No outside alcoholic beverages are allowed to be brought onto the premises.
- Any person found with alcohol not purchased from Princeton Golf Club will be asked to remove it from the premises or face further action.
- PGC reserves the right to inspect coolers and golf bags for outside alcohol. If outside alcohol is found, we reserve the right to confiscate that alcohol and return it after your round.
- If the PGC staff member is not permitted to look in the cooler or bag, you will be asked to leave the golf course immediately

Hours of Alcohol Service

Alcoholic beverages will be served during the following hours:

- Weekdays: [10:00am] to [closing]
- Weekends: [10:00 am] to [closing]
- Closing times vary and are posted outside Divots Bar and Grill. Alcoholic beverages may not be served outside these hours.

Eligibility for Purchase

- Alcohol may only be purchased by individuals who are of legal drinking age, as defined by local and provincial law.
- All individuals wishing to purchase alcohol may be asked to show valid identification (ID) upon request.

Consumption Locations

- Alcohol may only be consumed in designated areas, including the clubhouse, the golf course, and approved outdoor spaces.
- Alcoholic beverages are **not allowed on** the driving range, parking lot or in areas outside the designated alcohol consumption zones unless expressly permitted by the club.
- No Open alcohol when crossing the road.

Responsible Drinking

- Members and guests are encouraged to drink responsibly at all times.
- The club reserves the right to refuse service to any individual who is intoxicated, disruptive, or displays inappropriate behavior due to alcohol consumption.
- Intoxicated members or guests may be asked to leave the premises at the discretion of management and staff. If required, local RCMP will be contacted.

Event-Related Alcohol

• Special events or private functions hosted at the club may have different alcohol service hours and guidelines. These exceptions will be clearly communicated to attendees.

Clubhouse Staff Responsibility

• All staff members are trained to follow responsible alcohol-serving practices and ensure compliance with local laws regarding alcohol consumption.

Penalty for Violations

• Violations of this policy, including disorderly conduct due to alcohol Consumption Will result in removal from the premises.

Compliance with Local Laws

• Princeton Golf Club will adhere to all applicable local, provincial, and national laws and regulations regarding the sale, consumption, and distribution of alcohol.

Policy Amendments

This policy may be amended periodically, and all members and guests will be notified of changes as applicable.
